Valid from April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020

Michigan Hunting and fishing licenses are available at the Wilderness Visitor Center daily 10AM – 6PM ET, mid-May through mid- October and at the Headquarters Monday through Friday 8AM – 4:00PM, mid- October through mid- May.

COOL WATER FISH

LAKES

Lake of the Clouds Species: Smallmouth Bass, Perch

Regulations: <u>Fishing restricted to artificial lures only.</u> It shall be unlawful to use, or possess live bait, dead bait, organic or processed food or scented material at any time on the shore or water. <u>No spearing, no possession of smallmouth bass.</u>

Perch season – Open All year

Size and take limits: Perch only – no size limit, 25 in possession

Lake Superior

Non-Trout Species: Largemouth and Smallmouth Bass, Walleye, Northern Pike, Muskellunge, Yellow Perch, Sunfishes, White Bass, Lake Whitefish Cisco (lake herring), Lake Sturgeon, Smelt, All Others.

Regulation Totals:

SEASON FOR BASS:

JAN 1ST - Fri before Memorial Day; catch and immediate release only Saturday before Memorial Day - December 31st - Regular season Largemouth - 14" minimum, 5 possession limit Smallmouth Bass - 14"minimum, 5 possession limit

SEASON FOR WALLEYE, NORTHERN: May 15 – March 15

Walleye – 15" minimum, 5 possession limit

Northern Pike – 24" minimum, no more than 2 possession limit

SEASON FOR MUSKELLUNGE: 1ST Sat in June – March 15

Muskellunge – 42" minimum, LIMIT 1 FISH

SEASON FOR OTHERS: Open All Year:

Yellow Perch - No size limit, 25 take limit

Sunfishes - No size limit, 25 take limit in any combination of the listed species.

White bass – No size limit, 25 take limit

Lake Whitefish Cisco – No size limit, 12 in any combination

Smelt – No size limit, 2 gallon limit

All Others – No size limit, No take limit

NO FISHING SEASON

Lake Sturgeon - NO POSSESSION, MUST BE RELEASED IMMEDIATELY

TROUT AND SALMON WATERS

Note: An All-Species fishing license is required for all anglers, age 17 or older, to take and possess trout and salmon from any public waters.

LAKES

Lake Superior Species: Lake Trout & Splake, Salmon, Trout; Brown and Rainbow.

Regulation: Open All Year.

Size and take limits: Minimum size 15", 3 daily possession (no more than (1) lake trout 34" or

greater), 3 in any combination.

Note: for Brook Trout ONLY; size is 20" with only 1 allowed in possession.

Salmon, Brown and Rainbow Trout Size and Possession; 10" minimum, Take; 5 total in any combo,

no more than 3 of any one species, except up to 5 Coho, Chinook or Pink Salmon allowed.

Mirror Lake Species: Splake, Brook Trout

Regulations: Open All Year; no bait restrictions.

Size and Possession: Splake – 12", Brook Trout – 10" / 5 fish, with no more than

3 trout that are 15 inches or larger.

Lily Pond Species: Brook Trout, Splake

Regulations: Open All Year (non-designated trout lake); no bait restrictions.

Size and possession: Splake -8", Brook Trout -8", possession is 5 fish, with no more than 3 trout

15 inches or larger.

RIVERS & STREAMS

Rivers and streams are designated by "Type". All rivers & streams in the Porkies are Type 1 streams, except for the section of stream/rivers listed below. Type 1 is (open the last Sat. in April - Sept. 30), and size and take is 7" for Brook Trout, 8" Brown Trout, 10" for Rainbow Trout, Atlantic, Chinook, Coho and Pink Salmon. A daily possession of 5 fish with no more than 3 trout; 15 inches or larger.

River & Stream Type Exceptions:

Type 3 (Open all year)

Size: 15" on Brook Trout and Brown Trout, 10" on Atlantic, Chinook, Coho & Pink Salmon, Lake Trout,

Rainbow Trout. Possession: 5 fish, with no more than 3 trout 15 inches or larger.

Big Carp River Species: Brook Trout, Rainbow Trout, Pink Salmon

Regulations: from a point 100 yards downstream of Bathtub Falls (T50N, R45W, 1) to Lake

Superior.

Little Carp River Species: Brook Trout, Coaster Brook Trout

Regulations: from Traders Fall downstream to Lake Superior.

Little Iron River Species: Brook Trout, Salmon

Regulations: Upstream to Nonesuch Falls (T50N, R43N, 1).

Presque Isle River Species: Brook, Brown and Rainbow Trout, Coho, Chinook & Pink Salmon, Northern

Pike, Muskellunge, Walleye, Pan Fish.

Regulations: from Manabezho Falls downstream to Lake Superior

<u>Type 4</u> (Open last Sat in April – Sept. 30th for Brown & Brook Trout & Atlantic Salmon.

Open all year other trout and salmon species)

Size Minimum: 7" on Brook Trout, 10" on Brown Trout, Rainbow Trout, Atlantic, Coho, Chinook & Pink

Salmon.

Possession: 5 fish, with no more than 3 trout 15 inches or larger.

Union River Species: Brook Trout, Rainbow Trout

Regulations: from South Boundary Rd (T51N, R42W, 22) downstream to Lake Superior.
